

The Supreme Court has entered an Order declaring attorneys who have not complied with the mandatory IOLTA program to be administratively ineligible to practice law. The Court's Order was effective on October 22, 2018 and the list of ineligible attorneys is available on-line at <http://www.njcourts.gov> under Notices to the Bar for October 2018.

**IOLTA registration is not an online process. It is different than the Lawyers Fund for Client Protection. You must submit a paper form. There is no fee for IOLTA.**

The 2019 IOLTA Registration cycle will begin in early January, concurrent with the Annual Attorney Registration with the Court. We will offer online registration in the 2019 cycle. Information and instructions will be emailed to the attorney's billing email address on file with the Court. Online registration will become mandatory in 2020.

Attorneys are required to register their information annually and must also notify the Fund if they are no longer in private practice in New Jersey.
